Submission Text:** We have been notified of and having seen the non-CCI part of Novozymes submission regarding A1096, would like to express its support of the view brought forward by Novozymes that the enzyme object of A1096 should not be considered as “novel protein” for the reasons expressed in that submission. It must be taken into account that there are already a large variety of xylanases permitted for food uses which presents variations in their amino acid sequence. The xylanase submitted for approval is to be considered as any other xylanase because of its very high homology to all other xylanases and not as a novel protein.
